DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the position for 1/4 corner common to secs. 31 and 32, T. 26 N., R. 28 W.,
Found original stone, 18 x 14 x 8 inches, firmly set 14 inches into ground with
"1/4" on west face.
(Record: Same.)

From which:

A 10-inch lodgepole pine bears N. 79° E., 27 links, scribed "1/4 S 32 BT."
(Record: 8-inch pine bears N. 79° E., 27 links.)

A 10-inch lodgepole pine lying on ground, scribed "1/4 S 31 BT." The stump bears
S. 64°45' W., 8 links.
(Record: 8-inch pine bears S. 64°45' W., 8 links.)
