


Corner will be covered by road fill therefore I place a 3 foot high culvert over cap to protect it. Northeast BT will have fill around base therefore I establish new BT's.

A larch8" dia. bears $$12^{0}W$, 95.6 feet dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ \$18 BT.

A pine 12" dia., bears N45 $^{\circ}$ E, 53.4 feet dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S7 BT.

Attach BT and attention signs to trees and hang ribbon in area.
