
A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears N09°45'E, 32 lks. dist., mkd. "T26N R28W S18 BT".

A tamarack, 12 ins. diam., bears S30°30'E, 42 lks. dist., mkd. "T26N R28W S19 BT".

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S73°15'W, 84 lks. dist., mkd. "T26N R29W S24 BT".

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N76°15'W, 76 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S13 BT".

1985 Certified Corner Recordation by Thomas C. Hill, 5612S: Found stone, 14x11x10 ins., 5 ins. above the ground, firmly set and mkd. with 3 notches on S. face and witnessed by the original bearing trees. At the position of the stone, set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long 2 1/2 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground with an aluminum cap mkd. as shown.




