Set a limestone, 12x10x5 inches, 8 inches in the ground, for corners of Sections 27, 28, 33, and 34, marked with 1 notch on South and 3 notches on East edge; from which:

A 6" fir, bears N47°50'E, 14 links (9.24 feet) distant, marked "T26N R29W S27 BT"

An 8" tamarack, bears \$70°45'E, 9 links (5.94 feet) distant, marked "T26N R29W \$34 BT".

An 8" pine, bears \$23°50'W, 29 links (19.14 feet) distant, marked "T26N R29W \$33 BT".

An 8" pine, bears N26°W, 96 links (63.36 feet) distant, marked "T26N R29W S28 BT".

Re-monument:

The corner of Sections 27, 28, 33, and 34, monumented with a limestone, 12x10x5 inches, firmly set and marked with 3 grooves on the East and 1 groove on the South faces, and witnessed by the remains of two of the original bearing trees. At the corner point:


