A dead larch, 8 ins. diam., bears S08°W, 26 lks (17.2 ft.), marked T26N R29W S15 BT
A dead, larch, 10 ins. diam., bears N30°W, 39 lks (25.7 ft.), marked T26N R29W S10 BT

New bearing trees:
A larch, 6 ins. diam., bears N75°E, 33 lks (21.8 ft.), marked T26N R29W S11 BT
A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears S42°E, 41 lks (27.1 ft.), marked T26N R29W S14 BT
A larch, 6 ins. diam., bears S30°W, 30 lks (19.8 ft.), marked T26N R29W S15 BT
A pine 6 ins. diam, bears N24 1/2°W, 20 lks (13.2 ft.), marked T26N R29W S10 BT

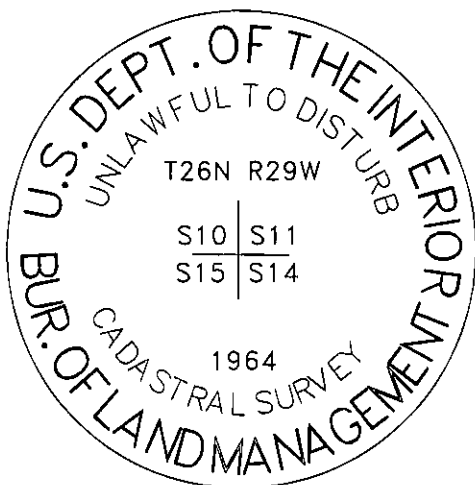
A larch, 9 ins. diam., bears N75°E, 17.2 ft., with visible scribes

Set steel post 3.0 ft., east of corner

2009 Found: We find a standard BLM monument with a 3 1/4" BLM brass cap, firmly set in good condition, 6" above the ground, marked as shown below, from which:

A 10" larch, bears N75°E, 21.7 ft., with overgrown blaze & BT tag "KSI '05"
A 14" larch, bears S42°E, 27.1 ft., with overgrown blaze & BT tag "N42°W 19.8' KSI '05"
A 10" larch, bears S30°W, 19.8 ft., with overgrown blaze & BT tag "N30°E 19.8' KSI '05"
A 10" Lodgepole pine, bears N24°W, 13.2 ft., with visible scribing & BT tag "S24°30'E 13.2 KSI '05"

2"X 18" PVC pipe on ground near monument containing "Notice of mining location" Bk 207 Pg 377"

2009 Perpetuation: We set a galvanized steel posts with USFS decals P54-1 & P71-10, 0.5 ft., east and 0.7 ft., south of the monument.
We paint red bands on the new bearing trees, and attached USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9.

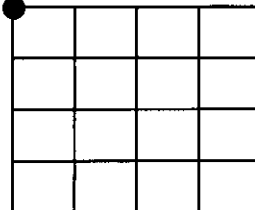
