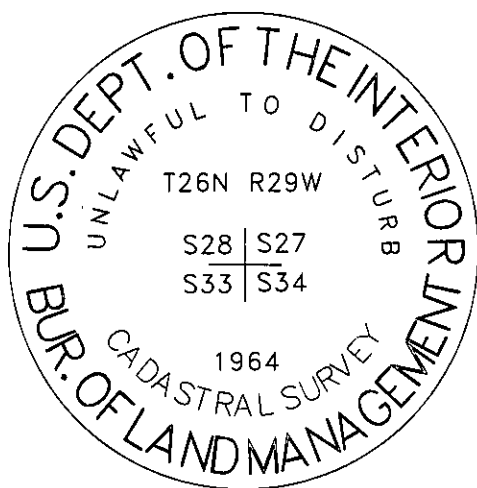

A 6" pine, bears S52°E, 27 lks (17.8 ft.), marked T26N R29W S34 BT
A 9" pine, bears S69°W, 26 lks (17.2 ft.), marked T26N R29W S33 BT
A 9" pine bears, N12-3/4°W, 18 lks (11.9 ft.), marked T26N R29W S28 BT

2006 Record: Found 3 1/4" BLM brass cap on 2 1/2" iron pipe, 6" above the ground, in a rock mound. From (Staples) which:

An 11" Doug. fir, bears, N15°W, 20.5 ft., scribed S28BT, w/ BT tag "S19°E 21.1 ft. By 4975"

2009 Found: We find a standard BLM monument with a 3 1/4" brass cap, firmly set, in good condition, rising 14" above the ground, marked as shown below, from which:
An 11" Lodgepole pine, bears N69°E, 28.3ft., with scribing visible.
A 12" Lodgepole pine, bears S53°E, 18.0 ft., with scribing visible.
A 16" Douglas fir, bears S53-1/2°W, 55.6 ft., with scribing visible.
An 11" Douglas fir, bears, N15°W, 20.5 ft., with scribing visible.

Galvanized steel post, bears south and west, 2.0 ft.

2009 Perpetuation: We establish no new reference monuments.
We attach new P54-1 & P71-10 signs on steel post.
We paint red bands on the existing bearing trees, and attached USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9.

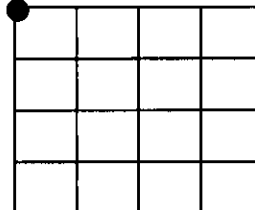
