A 42" pine snag, bears N36°10'W, 68 lks (44.9 ft.), mk'd 1/4 S34 BT (GLO Record 57

Set an iron post 30" long, 2 1/2" diam., 22" in the ground, with brass cap. Buried orig. stone alongside.

A galvanized steel post, bears West, 1.5 ft.


