- 5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana.

Set limestone and established 4 bearing trees

1978 BLM Record:

Found original stone and 4 original bearing trees.

An 18" pine, bears N65°E, 107 lks (70.62 ft.), with an overgrown blaze A 16" pine, bears S80 1/2°E, 91 lks (60.06 ft.), mk'd T25N R29W S2 BT

(GLO Record S80°30'E)

A 20" pine, bears S30°3/4'W, 140 lks (92.4 ft.), with an overgrown blaze A 12" pine, bears N22 1/4°W, 134 lks (88.4 ft.), mk'd T26N R29W S34 BT

(GLO Record 123 lks)

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, 2 1/2" diam., 16" in the ground, and in a supporting collar of stone 3 feet diameter to top, with brass cap. Buried original stone alongside the iron post.

2006 Record: (Staples)

Found standard 3 1/4" brass cap on 2 1/2" iron pipe, 1 1/2 ft. above the ground in a mound of stone, from which:

"S65°W, 107 lks(70.62 ft.)"

A 19" Ponderosa pine, bears N22 1/4°W, 87.60 ft., with a partially overgrown scribe

"26NR29WS3" & BT tag "S22 1/4°, 134 lks(88.44 ft.)"

2009 Found:

We find a standard BLM monument with a 3 1/4" brass cap, firmly set, in good condition, rising 18" above the ground, in mound of stone; marked as shown below, from which:

A 20" Ponderosa pine bears N64 1/2°E, 70.3 ft., with an overgrown blaze An 18" Ponderosa pine bears S80 3/4°E, 61.3 ft., with visible scribing

A 24" Ponderosa pine stump, 5 ft. high, bears S29 1/2°W, 93.3 ft., with an overgrown

blaze

An 18" Ponderosa pine bears N25°W, 87.6 ft., with visible scribing


