3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor to State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

1. (a) 1903 - B.L.M. Original record; set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 3,4,9 and 10 marked:

T26N S3 on NE,
R29W S10 on SE,
S9 on SW, and
S4 on NW faces; marked with 5 notches on S and 3 notches on E edge, from which:

- A Fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N80°E, 25 lks dist., marked T26N R29W S3BT.
- A Tamarack, 30 ins. diam., bears S71° 45'E, 7 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S10BT.
- A Pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S22°45'W, 20 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S9BT.
- A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N54°W, 40 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S4BT.

(b) 1964 - B.L.M. record; found a disintegrated wooden post, firmly set in the ground, and witnessed by the remains of two of the original bearing trees. At the corner point; Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam. 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked as shown below; from which:

The remains of the original bearing trees:

- A stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S71-3/4°E, 7 lks. dist., visible marks BT.(Record)
- A Pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S22-3/4°W, 20 lks. dist., marked with an overgrown blaze. (Record)

The new bearing trees:

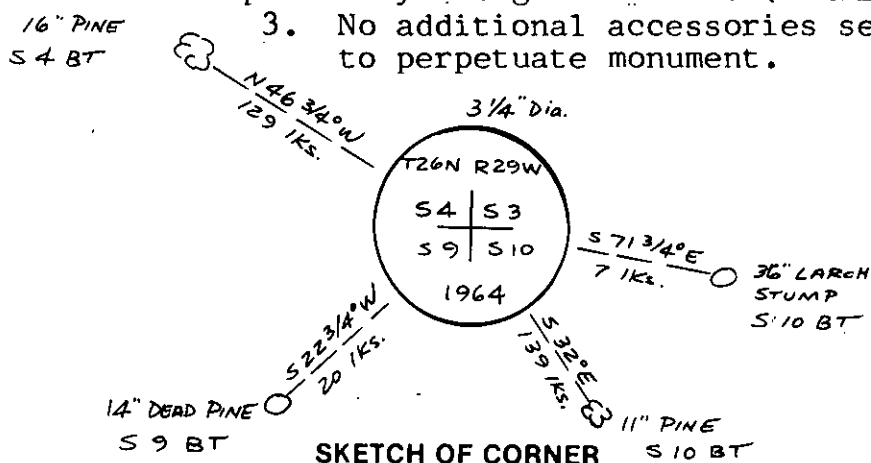
- A Pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S32°E, 139 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S10BT.
- A Pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N46-3/4°W, 129 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S4BT.

Bury the remains of the original wooden post alongside of the iron post.

2. 1982 - Found a 2 1/2" iron post approx. 8 ins. above ground with BLM brass cap marked as shown below; from which:

- A Larch stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S71-3/4°E, 7 lks. dist., visible marks BT (Record)
- A dead Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S22-3/4°W, 20 lks. dist., marked with an overgrown blaze, partially opened (Record)
- A Pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S32°E, 139 lks. dist., marked with partially overgrown blaze. (Record)
- A Pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N46-3/4°W, 129 lks. dist., marked with partially overgrown blaze. (Record)

3. No additional accessories set to perpetuate monument.

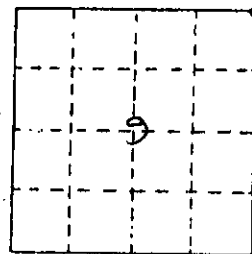
