5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.



1. {a} 1903 - B.L.M. Original Record;  
Set a limestone, 22x16x8 ins., 17 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, marked with 4 notches, each, on S. and E. edges, from which:  
A tamarack, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 38°10' E., 18 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S9 BT.  
A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 73° E., 19 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S16 BT.  
A pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 31°45' W., 25 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S17 BT.  
A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 19° W., 25 lks. dist., marked T26N R29W S8 BT.  
{b} 1964 - B.L.M. record; found a limestone, 22x16x8 ins., firmly set and marked with 4 grooves on the S. and E. faces, and witnessed by the remains of one of the original bearing trees. At the corner point. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked as shown below; from which:  
The remains of the original bearing tree:  
A stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 18 lks. dist., with illegible scribing. {Record: N. 38°10' E., 18 lks.}  
The new bearing trees:  
A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 75 3/4° E., 20 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S9 BT.  
A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 9° E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S16 BT.  
A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 33° W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S17 BT.  
A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 62° W., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S8 BT.  
Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post.
2. 1982 - Found a 2 1/2 ins. iron post, approx. 2 ins. above ground with B.L.M. brass cap marked as shown below; from which:  
A stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 18 lks. dist., with illegible scribing. {Record: N. 38°10' E., 18 lks.}  
A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 75 3/4° E., 20 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S9 BT.  
A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 9° E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S16 BT.  
A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 33° W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S17 BT.  
A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 62° W., 19 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R29W S8 BT.  
A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears approx. North, approx. 8 ft., with location poster.
