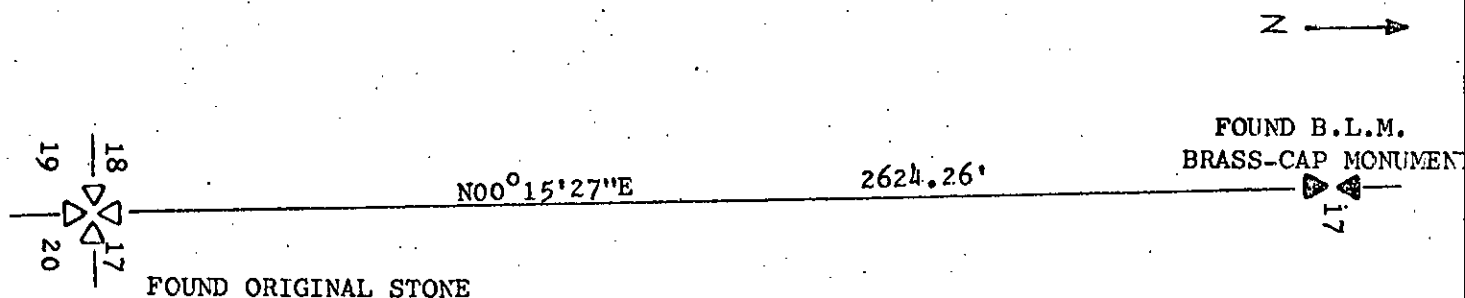

A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 46° E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S30 BT.

A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 63° W., 10 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 30, monumented with a limestone, 12 x 10 x 5 ins., firmly set and mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of one of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 61° W., 5 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S19 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 18, monumented with a limestone, 14 x 10 x 5 ins., loosely set and mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ on the W. face, and witnessed by the remains of one of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, monumented with a limestone, 14 x 8 x 6 ins., firmly set and mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face, and witnessed by the remains of one of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pine, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 36° E., 36 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 BT.

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 15° W., 16 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S17 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post.

Township 26 North, Range 30 West

These field notes are those of the remonumentation of certain corners of the survey executed by Fred I. Hubbard, in 1903, in Township 26 North, Range 30 West, of the Principal Meridian, Montana.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with a sandstone, 14 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set and mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
