

Sec Cor. Secs. 16, 17, 20, 21 Lincoln Corner. County

1900 G.L.O. record by Burton S. Adams: Set a limestone and four bearing trees.

1984 Land Corner Record by Dick R. Griffin: Found set granite stone (3" X 12" X 6" high) with 4 notches on South and 4 notches on East face. Rock pile on North East side. Location sign is posted on 6 in. larch 11 1ks. N 75 E of corner.

Set a 3" X 30" aluminum pipe with 3 1/2" aluminum cap stamped as shown below. Buried original stone upside down on East side of pipe. Raised a 3' diameter X 1' high granite mound around monument. Drove 6' steel post with 54-9 sign 1' North of corner. Monument protruding 6".

- A 10" ponderosa pine bears N 41°W, 21.9'.
 A 10" ponderosa pine bears N 50°E, 13.3'.
 A 15" ponderosa pine bears S 50°E, 14.5'.
 A 8" larch bears S 39°W, 15.3'.

All BT's are base blazed and scribed "BT" with blaze painted red. All BT's have 6' red band painted 6' high and 54-3 signs attached.

II. Found a U.S.F.S. aluminum cap firmly set in place, with small rock collar, marked as shown above, and a 6 ft. galv. steel post 1 ft. NORTH of corner.


