

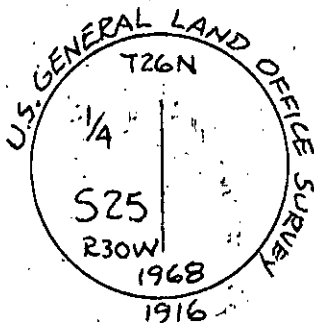
INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

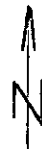
Corner East 1/4 Corner Section 25 T. 26N R. 30W P.M.M. Lincoln County

1. 40 chains: Set an iron post 3 feet long 1 inch in diameter, 24" in the ground, for 1/4 Section Corner for Section 25 only, with Brass cap marked 1/4S25/1916 and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high W. of corner.
2. Found: 1916 brass cap from which a 10" Pine bears N 85°W 7 links scribed, but grown over. An 8" Pine bears S 11°E 11 links scribed "X" B.T. both trees posted by Art 1968 a location poster on 10" Pine B.T. and an attention poster on 12" Fir 6 ft. from corner.
3. Painted corner monument and bearing trees with bright red paint.

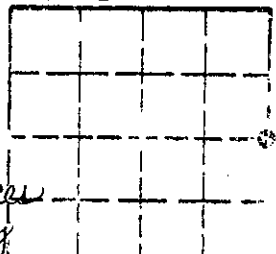
