1. 1908 Original Record by Howard B. Grant: Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked with one notch on the S. and 5 on the N. edge; I mark four bearing trees.

1916 Resurvey of Fractional T.26 N. R.30 W. by S. Frank Walters, Carl Dyson and Donald MacRae: Set a iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25 and 36, with brass cap marked



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

1968 B.L.M. Remonumentation: The cor. of secs. 25 and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 36 ins. long, 3 ins. diam., loosely set 12 ins. in the ground and witnessed by a mound of stone W. Add additional marks 1968 to brass cap.

At the corner point

Reset the iron post, 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



The new bearing trees:

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears  $8.60^{\circ}$ W., 44 lks. dist., (29.0 ft.) mkd. T26N R30W 836 BT. A pine. 7 ins. diam., bears N.77  $3/4^{\circ}$ W., 18 lks. dist., (11.9 ft.) mkd. T26N R30W 825 BT.

- II. Found a 3 1/2 ins. diam., G.L.O. brass cap on a 3 ins. diam iron post, mkd. as shown above, from which A fir, 11 ins. dia., bears S.58°E., 29.0 ft. dist., visible scribing 26N R 36 A pine, 11 ins. dia., bears N.76°W., 12.0 ft. dist., scribe overgrown.
- III. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. Set a galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, South 1.8 ft. Magnetic Declination  $20^{\circ}$ E.
