A tamarack, 24 ins. diam., bears N.75 $^{\circ}$ W., 183 lks. dist.,(120.8 ft.) mkd. 1/4 s 34 BT. 1968 B.L.M. Remonumentation: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with a limestone 20x10x4 ins., firmly set, mkd. 1/4 on the W. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees. At the corner point Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins diam., 24 ins in the ground, with a brass cap mkd. 
