

# CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1 MS 7368A Sec. 12 T. 26 N R. 31 W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1904 G.L.O. original survey by Abram L. Jaqueth: Set a quartzite stone, 30 x 15 x 7 ins., 24 ins. deep, chiseled 1-7368A, from which:

A balsam fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N80°E, 25.4 ft. dist., scribed "B.T. 1-7368A".  
A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S72°20'W, 24.6 ft. dist., scribed "B.T. 1-7368 A".

II. Found a stone, firmly set, 12 x 7 ins., 8 ins. above ground, with visible chisel marks on the SW face, from which:

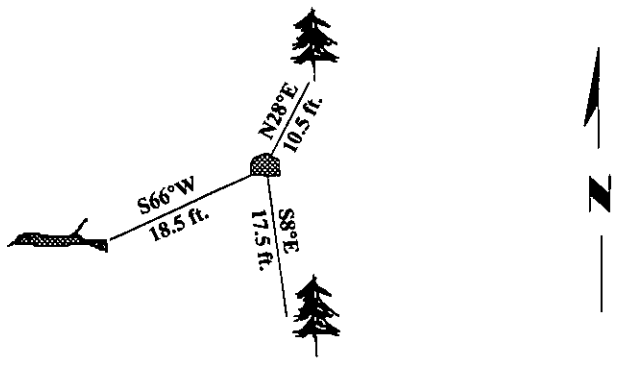
Rotten remains, bears S66°W, 18.5 ft. dist. (Rec. S72°W, 24.6 ft.).

III. Established two new bearing trees:

A hemlock, 9 ins. diam., bears N28°E, 10.5 ft. dist., scribed "1 MS 7368A BT."  
A hemlock, 7 ins. diam., bears S8°E, 17.5 ft. dist., scribed "1 MS 7368A BT."  
(Distances measured to faces of B.T.'s).

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.

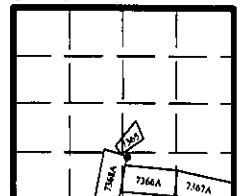
