

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 4 MS 7368A Sec. 13 T. 26 N R. 31 W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1904 G.L.O. original survey by Abram L. Jaqueth: Set a quartzite stone, 25 x 12 x 10 ins., 20 ins. deep, chiseled 4-7368A, from which:

A balsam fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S66°20'E, 12.3 ft. dist., scribed "B.T. 4-7368A".
A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S89°40'W, 12.3 ft. dist., scribed "B.T. 4-7368 A".

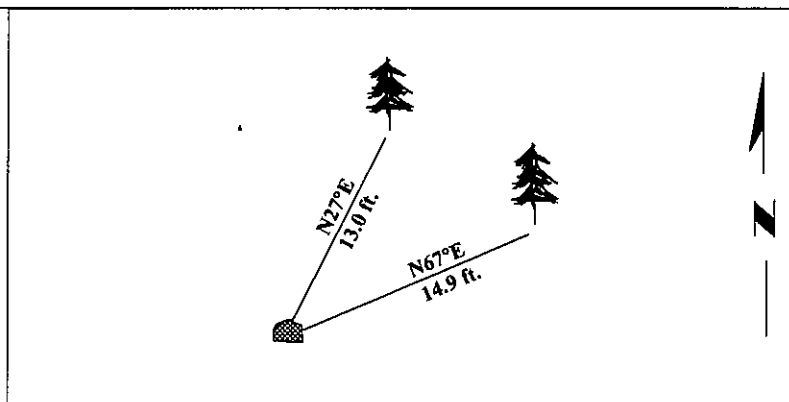
II. Found a stone, firmly set, 9 x 9 ins., 9 ins. above ground, chiseled "4/7366A" on NW face and "X" on top. (Note: Stone marked incorrectly). No evidence of original bearing trees found, due to extreme wild fire activity.

III. Established two new bearing trees:

A hemlock, 11 ins. diam., bears N27°E, 13.0 ft. dist., scribed "4 MS 7368A BT."
A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N67°E, 14.9 ft. dist., scribed "4 MS 7368A BT."
(Distances measured to faces of B.T.'s).

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.

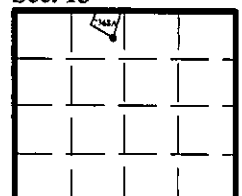
