
A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears  $N70^{\circ}30$ 'E, 35 lks. dist., mkd. T27N R26W S7 B.T. A pine, 20 ins. diam., bears  $834^{\circ}$ E, 17 lks. dist., mkd. T27N R26W S18 B.T.

II. Found a firmly set stone 5x12 ins. 9 ins. above ground, with 2 groves on N. and 4 groves on S. and C.C. on E. face.

from which:

A pine stump,  $2^{4}$  ins. diam., bears N70 E, 22.8 lks. dist., with B.T. visible A pine snag, 17 ins. diam., bears S34 E, 11.4 lks. dist., C.C. T27N R26W S18 B.T. visible.

III. At the position of found stone, set a 2 1/2 ins. diam., aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground with a 3 1/4 ins. diam., aluminum cap, mkd. as shown:



Establish 2 new bearing trees:

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N77  $^{\circ}$ E, 15.9 ft. dist., mkd. T27N R26W S7 C.C. B.T. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S18  $^{\circ}$ E, 20.2 ft. dist., mkd. T27N R26W S18 C.C. B.T.

Bury the original stone alongside and raise a rock collar around new monument.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

No guard post set.
