Set a limestone 20x10x4 inches, 15 inches in the ground for 1/4 Section corner marked 1/4 on west face; from which:

A fir, 10 inches diameter, bears N24°W, 32 links (21.12 feet) distant, marked ¼ S21 BT.

A fir, 24 inches diameter, bears S84°E, 84 links (55.44 feet) distant, marked 1/4 S22 BT.

BLM - 1969

The 1/4 corner of Sections 21 and 22 as determined from the remains of one of the original bearing trees.

A snag bears S84°E, 84 links (55.44 feet) distant, marked ¼ S22 BT.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 inches long, 2½ inches diameter, 24 inches in the ground with brass cap marked as shown below.

Bury the original stone along side and raise a collar of stone, 2 feet diameter, around the iron post. (Corner determined from bearing trees, no stone was found).

FOUND:

Found a 31/4" BLM brass cap, marked as shown below, 0.3' above ground. No evidence of original bearing trees were found.

ESTABLISH:


Established two new accessories for this corner:

A 14 inch Douglas fir bears N84°52'14"E, 12.35 feet distant, blaze and scribe "1/4 S22 BT".

A 13 inch pine bears S71°46'23"W, 66.54 feet distant, blaze and scribe "1/4 S21 BT".

Bearing tree tags were attached and trees were painted red.
