

Corners such as meander corners or subdivision corners which are not located at intersecting lines on the above diagram will be identified by reference to the nearest applicable coordinate lines, thus: AB-1; M-1-2; VW-19-20.

Corners common to adjoining townships will be identified by coordinates of the townships in which the certificates are to be filed.
