Found original wooden post lying on ground, plainly marked 10571
(Record - A fir post 5 ft. long, 6 in. square, set 2 ft. in ground, with mound of earth, scribed N.B. 4-10571.) from which:
A fir 15 in. diam. bears N 19°17'E -10.3 ft., alive and all scribing visible
(Record - A fir 14 in. Diam. bears N 19°17'E - 10.3 ft. blazed and scribed cross BT NB 4 10571.)

A Larch 14 in. diam. bears S 53°E - 18.1 Ft. alive and all scribing visible
(Record - A lch. 12 in. diam. bears S 51°56'E - 18.1 Ft. blazed and scribed cross BT NB 4 10571.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
