DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found rotted remains of squared post (Record - A fir post, 5 ft. long, 6 ins. square, set 2 ft. in ground, with mound of earth, scribed MQ 3 10571.) from which:

A 1ch. 27 In. Diam. bears N 2°57'E - 76.1 ft. alive with all scribing visible (Record - A 1ch. 24 in. diam. bears N 2°57'E - 76.1 ft. blazed and scribed cross BT MQ 3 10571.)

A 1ch. 25 in. diam. bears N 61°10'E - 44.1 ft. alive with scribing overgrown (Record - A 1ch. 20 in. diam. bears N 61°10'E - 44.1 ft. blazed and scribed cross BT MQ 3 10571.)

For cor. No. 3, "Mountain Queen Lode" MS No. 10571

I set a 2 in. galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground, with
brass cap marked. I set corner from original bearings and distances.

The original BT's were alive and in good condition.
I placed signs and paint on BT's and at corner.
