

- I. <u>1926 Mineral Survey original record by Charles H. Goodsell:</u> A fir post, 5 ft. long, 7 ins. square, set 2 ft. in the ground, with a mound of earth, scribed L C 4-10571. NE Loc. Cor. N82° 55'E, 90 feet.
- II. No evidence found of orig. wooden post or of the NE Loc. Corner.
- III. At the position determined by survey, set a 2 1/2 in. diam., 30 in. long. alum. pipe, 22 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. alum. cap mkd. as shown:




from which:

A pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S51°W, 98.7 ft. dist., mkd. "4 LC 10571 BT". A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N70°W, 33.7 ft. dist., mkd. "1 MQ 10571 BT".

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with LSM and PB decals, on line, bearing S44°W, approx. 3 ft. from monument.
