

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION
(REFERENCE FSM 7153.53)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original Corner stone firmly set and marked with a mound of stone and earth alongside. (Record - set a quartzite stone 24x8x6 ins., 12 ins. deep, chiseled 1-8797.) (Record - raised a mound of earth and stone alongside.) from which:

A cedar 24 in. diam. bears N35°E-8.1 ft. alive with all scribing visible. (Record - a blazed cedar tree 20 in. diam., scribed BT 1-8797, bears N 35° E - 8.1 ft.)

A lch. 26 in. diam. bears S 29° 15' E - 21.1 ft. alive and overgrown. (Record - a blazed fir tree 24 in. diam., scribed BT 1-2797, bears S 29° 15' E - 21.1 ft.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 11/3/70

For Corner No. 1. "Johnstone Placer" MS No. 8797 I set a 2" galvanized Iron pipe 20 inches in the ground at the exact center of the original corner stone, with brass cap marked
I raised a colar of stone 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high around the iron pipe, and buried the original corner stone alongside the iron pipe.
