DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original wooden post lying on ground, scribed 4-8796 (Record - set a fir post, 4 in. square, 4 ft. long, 2 ft. deep, scribed 4-8796.)
Found rotted remains of original wooden post in mound of earth and stone. From which:
A fir 14 in. diam. bears N 70° W - 6.3 ft. alive and overgrown (Record - a blazed fir tree 12 in. diam., scribed BT 4-8796, bears N 70° W, 6.3 ft.) A fir 18 in. diam. bears S 89° E - 20.0 ft. snag with all scribing visible (Record - a blazed fir tree 16 in. diam., scribed BT 4-8796, bears S 89° E, 20.0 ft.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

For corner No. 4, "Old Judge Lode" MS No. 8796 I set a 2 in. galvanized iron pipe 18 inches in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap marked
Raised a collar of stone 2 ft. base 1 ft. high around iron pipe. From which:
a 9 in. Douglas fir bears S 28° W - 16.8 ft. dist. Marked RM
I placed signs and paint on BT's and at corner.
