DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original corner post firmly set and marked (Record - A tamarack post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square set 2 ft. in ground with mound of earth, scribed M. 4-8995.) from which:

A larch 24 in. diam. bears West - 2 ft., alive and overgrown (Record - A blazed tamarack tree 22 ins. in diam. scribed B.T. M 4-8995, bears West 2 ft.)

A larch 17 in. diam. bears S21½°E - 24.5 ft., snag with scribing partly visible. (Record - A blazed tamarack tree 15 ins. in diam. scribed B.T. M 4-8995, bears S 40°E - 24.5 Ft.)

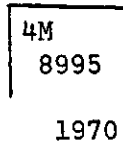

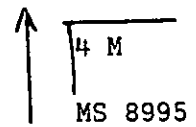
