DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found original corner post firmly set and marked (Record - set a post 4 inches square, 4 ft. long, 2 ft. deep, scribed 3-7684.) from which:

A larch 14 in. diam. bears N32°W-14.5 ft., snag with all scribing visible.
(Record - A blazed tamarack tree, 12 inches in diameter, scribed 3-7684 BT, bears N32°W - 14.5 ft.)

A pine 12 in. diam. bears S4°E- 10.0 ft., down and decayed.
(Record - A blazed pine tree, 12 inches in diameter, scribed 3-7684 BT, bears S4°E, 10 Ft.,)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED

I set a 2 in. galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground, with brass cap marked.

I set corner in exact center point of original wooden post from which:

A larch 5 in. diam. bears S10½°E - 13.10 Ft., marked RM

A larch 6 in. diam. bears S11°W - 5.6 Ft., marked RM

I placed signs and paint on BT's and at corner
