
## **CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION**

Corner MS 8995 COR. 3 Sec. 12 T. 27N R. 31W P.M., MT. Lincoln County Mascot LODE

I. 1909 Original Mineral Survey No. 8995 by Aurthur E. Lee et. al.: Cor. No. 3, identical with Cor. No. 5. of Mineral Survey No. 7431 and identical with Cor. No. 4. of the Yellow Jacket Placer and Cor. No. 1. of the Yellow Jacket No. 2 Placer, both of this Survey. A blazed tamarack post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in the ground with a mound of earth, scribed M. Y 3-Y.J. No. 2. 1-8995.

A blazed pine tree, 13 ins. diam., bears West, 12.0 ft. dist., scribed B.T.M. 3-Y.J. 4-Y.J. No. 2 1-8995. A blazed tamarack tree, 14 ins. diam., bears S 5°E, 53.0 ft. dist., scribed B.T.M. 3-Y.J. 4-Y.J. No. 2 1-8995.

- III. At the position determined by survey: set a 2 1/2 ins. diam., alum. pipe, 30 ins. long, 7 ins. above ground with a 3 1/4 in. diam. alum. cap mkd. as shown:




from which:

A hemlock, bears S22°E, 20.1 ft. dist., mkd. "3-Mascot BT". A hemlock, bears N72°W, 13.8 ft. dist., mkd. "1 YJ 2 BT"

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
