

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Closing corner common to Sec. 13 and 24, T28N R27½W, MPM
Found original stone shattered and loosely set (Record - set a limestone, 20 X 12 X 10 ins. 15 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, marked cc on W, with 3 grooves on S and 3 grooves on N. faces.) from which:

A pine, 10 in. diam. bears S17°30'W - 33 lks., alive with scribing visible. (Record - a pine, 8 ins. diam. bears S17° 30'W, 33 lks. dist., marked T28N R27½W S 24BT.)
A larch, 13 in. diam. bears N68°45'W -62 lks., alive with scribing visible. (Record - A tamarack, 8 ins. diam. bears N 68°45'W, 62 lks. Dist., marked T28N R27½W S 13 B.T.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

I set a 2 in. galvanized iron pipe 24 inches in the ground with brass cap marked.

I set corner from record bearing and distance from two BT's, and buried the shattered remains of the original corner stone alongside the iron pipe.

I placed signs and paint on BT's and at corner.
