1902 G.L.O. record by B. S. Adams and W. B. Weeks: Set a stone monument and marked two bearing trees.

1970 B.L.M. remonumentation record by J. E. French: "The 1/4 cor. of secs. 13 and 24, monumented with a limestone, 15x12x10 ins. loosely set, mkd. 1/4 on the N. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees:

A stump hole, bears S26  $1/4^{\circ}$  W, 83 lks. dist., with a fallen fir, 20 ins. diam., mkd. with an overgrown blaze, lying alongside.

A larch, 24 ins. diam., bears N4  $1/4^{\circ}$ W, 42 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S BT.

At the corner point; set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground,

T28N R27 1/2W S13 s24 1970

from which a new bearing tree:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S69  $1/2^{\circ}$ E, 18 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S24 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post.

II. Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron pipe, 6 ins. above ground with rock collar and 3 1/4 ins. diam. B.L.M. brass cap, mkd. as shown above; from which


A larch, 26 ins. diam., bears N4 W, 27.9 ft. (42 lks.) dist., visible scribe. (G.L.O.) A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S69 E, 11.8 ft. (18 lks.) dist., mkd. 1/4 S24 BT. (B.L.M.) A downed fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S26 W, 54.8 ft. (83 lks.) dist., scribe face down. (G.L.O.)

III. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals. South, 3 ft.
