

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1/4 of Secs. 25 & 26 T. 28 N. R. 27 1/2 W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

I. 1902 G.L.O. record by B. S. Adams and W. B. Weeks: Marked a rock in place and marked two bearing trees.

1978 B.L.M. remonumentation record by L. A. Christiansen: "The 1/4 cor. of secs. 25 and 26, monumented with a rock in place, 20x12x5 ins. above ground, mkd. with an (x) at the cor. point, and 1/4 on the W. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees:

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S43° E, 11 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S25 BT (Record: S46 1/2° E).

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N52° W, 8 lks. dist., with an overgrown blaze. (Record: N48 3/4° W)

At the corner point; set a brass tablet, 3 1/4 ins. diam., 3 1/2 in. stem, in solid rock, with top mkd.

Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., around the brass tablet."

II. Found 3 1/4 ins. diam. B.L.M. brass tablet loose and laying on the ground; from which

A downed pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S46° E, 7.3 ft. (11 lks.) dist., mkd. 1/4 S2 BT.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N50° W, 5.3 ft. (8 lks.) dist., healed face.

III. Set by distance - distance intersection from found bearing trees; a 2 1/2 ins. diam. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 19 ins. in the ground with 3 1/4 ins. diam. aluminum cap, marked as shown:

from which (marked one new bearing tree):

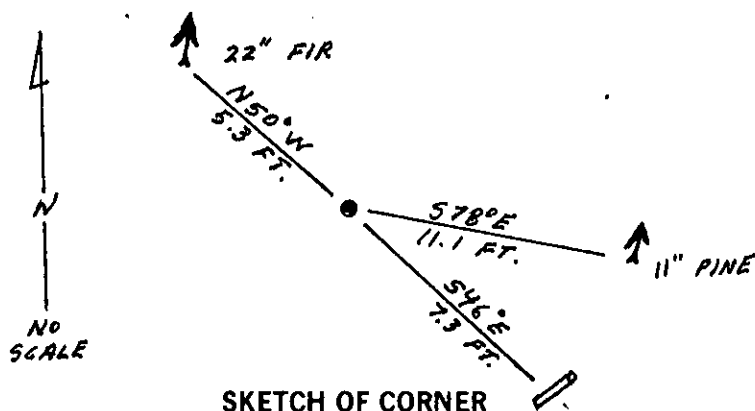
A pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S78° E, 11.1 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S25 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Raise a collar of stone around aluminum monument.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, West, 2.5 ft.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East

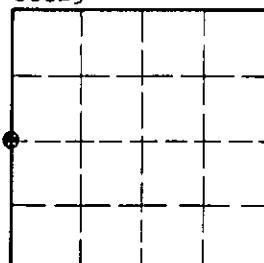
