1978 B.L.M. remonumentation record by L. A. Christiansen: "The 1/4 cor. of secs. 25 and 26, monumented with a rock in place, 20x12x5 ins. above ground, mkd. with an (x) at the cor. point, and 1/4on the W. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees:

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears $543^{\circ}E$, 11 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S25 BT (Record: S46 $1/2^{\circ}E$). A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N52 W, 8 lks. dist., with an overgrown blaze. (Record: N48 3/4 W)

At the corner point; set a brass tablet, 3 1/4 ins. diam., 3 1/2 in. stem, in solid rock, with top mkd.



III. Set by distance - distance intersection from found bearing trees; a 2 1/2 ins. diam. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 19 ins. in the ground with 3 1/4 ins. diam. aluminum cap, marked as shown:



from which (marked one new bearing tree):


