DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Closing corner common to Sec. 3 and 4, T.28N R.27W, MPM  
Found original stone firmly set and plainly marked (Record - Set a limestone 15 X 12 X 8 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. to Secs. 3 and 4, marked C.C. with 3 notches on E and W faces,) from which:  
  
A pine 16 ins. diam. bears S20°W - 17 lks. dist., snag with all scribing visible.  
(Record - A pine 14 ins. diam. bears S20°W - 17 lks. dist. marked T28N R27W. cc S4 BT.)  
  
A larch 21 ins. diam. bears N29°E - 10 lks. dist., stump with BT. visible.  
(Record - A tamarack 20 ins. diam. bears N29°E - 10 lks. dist. marked T28N R27W cc S 3 & 4 BT.)

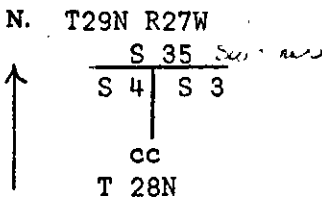
