
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

- I. 1891 G.L.O. Original Record by Newton Orr: Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33, & 34, mkd. "T28N S27" on NE; "R27W S34" on SE; "S33" on SW, and "S28" on NW faces, with 1 notch on S. and 3 notches on E. edges. Established four bearing trees.
- II. No evidence found of original post, found one original bearing tree and one root crown, from which:

A larch root crown, bears N83°E, 40.9 ft. dist., no visible marks. (record-N78°E) A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S48°W, 16.5 ft. dist. "33" visible. (record-S41°W)

III. By distance-distance intersect, using record distances from the original found bearing trees, set a 30 in. long, 3/4 in. diam. aluminum rod, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, 24 ins. in the ground, mkd. as shown:



Established three new bearing trees:

A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears N40°E, 68.20 ft. dist., mkd. "T28N R27W S27 BT". A larch, 19 ins. diam., bears S83°E, 17.60 ft. dist., mkd. "T28N R27W S34 BT". A larch, 8 ins. diam., bears N02°W, 48.1 ft. dist., mkd. "T28N R27W S28 BT".

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
