

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1/4 of Secs. 35 & 36 T. 28 N. R. 29 W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

I. 1903, G.L.O. original record by Fred I. Hubbard:

1970, B.L.M. remonumentation record by Joseph E. French: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a quartzite stone, 12 x 8 x 8 ins., firmly set, mkd. 1/4 on the W. face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees:

A larch, 18 ins. diam., bears S45° E, 39 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S36 BT.

A dead larch, 12 ins. diam., bears N53° W, 14 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S35 BT.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which a new bearing tree:

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S82° W, 23 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S35 BT.

Bury the original stone alongside the iron post."

II. Found, a set 2 1/2 in. dia. iron pipe, 9 ins. out of the ground with 3 1/4 in. dia., B.L.M. brass cap, marked as shown:

A larch snag, 15 ins. dia., bears S42° E, 25.9 ft. (39.2 lks.) dist., all scribe visible (G.L.O. rcd.)

A fir (top broken off), 8 ins. dia., bears S82° W, 15.6 ft. (23.6 lks.) dist., partial scribe visible (B.L.M. rcd.)

A larch snag, 8 ins. dia., bears N50° W, 9.3 ft. (14 lks.) dist., partial scribe visible (G.L.O. rcd.)

III. Established two new bearing trees:

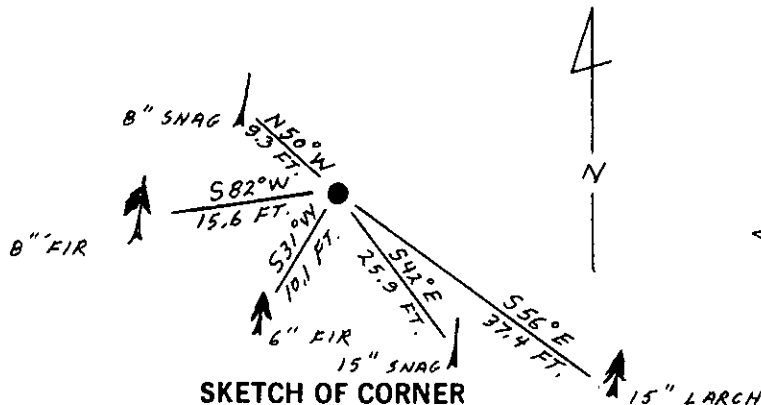
A larch, 15 ins. dia., bears S56° E, 37.4 ft. dist., scribed 1/4 S36 BT.

A douglas fir, 6 ins. dia., bears S31° W, 10.1 ft. dist., scribed 1/4 S35 BT.

Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs where needed.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals, South, 3 ft.

Magnetic Declination: 20° 30' East

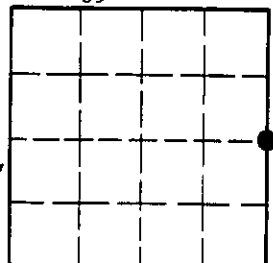
