



An iron rebar, 24 ins. long, 5/8 ins. diam., set 22 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S73*42'51"W, 85.14 ft. dist., with a 3 1/4 ins. diam., aluminum U.S.F.S. cap mkd. RM 1.
