

  Set an iron rebar, 24 ins. long, 5/8 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 ins. diam., aluminum U.S.F.S cap mkd. as shown:

A larch, 22 ins. diam., bears S24\*W, 13.7 ft. dist., mkd. CENESE 1/256 S34 BT. A grand fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N86\*W, 26.0 ft. dist., mkd. CENESE 1/256 S34 BT.




