

II. Found a stone 3x9x13 ins., laying loose on the ground. mkd. with 5 grooves on W. face and 1 groove on E. face and "CC" facing up, from which

III. At the determined corner position, distance - distance intersect from found original bearing trees. I set a 2 1/2 inch dia. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 25 ins. in the ground with attached 3 1/4 ins. dia. U.S.D.A. Forest Service aluminum cap mkd. as shown:



Placed a collar of stone around monument and buried the original stone alongside pipe.
