
- I. 1900 G.L.O. original record by Burton S. Adams: Set a slate stone, 18x10x4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, mkd. "1/4" on the N. face, from which:
 - A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S2°45'W, 63 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S27 BT".
 - A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N14°15'W, 86 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S22 BT".

1969 B.L.M. record by Roy G. Leedy: The 1/4 corner of secs. 22 and 27, as determined from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A stump, bears S2 3/4°W, 65 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S27 BT".

A stump hole, bears N14 1/4°W, 86 lks. dist.

At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground., with brass cap mkd.:



from which two new bearing trees were established:

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N38°E, 56 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S22 BT".

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S3°W, 70 lks. dist., scribed "1/4 S27 BT".

Raised a collar of stone, 2 ft. diam., around the iron post.

1984 CCR by Thomas C. Hill: Found a 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron pipe, with BLM brass cap, 7 ins. above ground with a small collar of stome around pipe, mkd. as shown, from which:

A Douglas fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N39°E, 37.4 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM).

A Douglas fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S4°W, 46.8 ft. dist., with a healed face. (BLM).

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, firmly set, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. brass cap, 8 ins. above ground, mkd. as shown above, from which:

A fir stump, bears N39°E, 36.8 ft. (56 lks.) dist., with visible scribing.

A stump, bears S3°W, 41.3 ft. (63 lks.) dist., with visible scribing. (GLO).


A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S4°W, 46.8 ft. (71 lks.) dist., with healed face.

III. Established one new bearing tree:


A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N60°E, 37.2 ft. dist., scribed "1/4 S22 BT".
