
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner 1/4 Sec. 18 T. 29N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1932 B.L.M. Resurvey of the Horse Plains Guide Meridian by Fred L. Cumming et al.: Point for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 18, as hereafter determined. Set an iron post, 3 ins. long, 1 in. in diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. for sec.18, withthe brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established two bearing trees:

A larch, 6 ins. diam., bears N84°E, 12 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S18 BT". A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears S60°E, 22 lks. dist., mkd. "1/4 S18 BT".

- II. Found a 1 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 1.4 ft. above the ground, firmly set, with a 2 1/2 in. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown above. No bearing trees found.
- III. No suitable trees within limits, therefore, from the corner point, I set two posts:


A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears North, on property line, 10.0 ft. dist.

A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears South, on property line, 2.95 ft. dist.
