
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner Sec. Cor. Sec. 11,12, T. 29N R. 26W P.M., MT Lincoln County 13&14

- I. 1893 G.L.O. Original Record by James S. Keerl et, al.: Set a sandstone, 24X10X6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11,12,13&14, mkd. with 4 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. edges. Established four bearing trees:
 - A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N27°E, 24 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S12 BT".
 - A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S35°E, 6 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S13 BT"
 - A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S59°W, 24 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S14 BT".
 - A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N34°W, 37 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S11 BT"

1965 B.L.M. Remonumentation Record by Duane G. Lindenberg: The corner of 11,12,13&14, monumented with a sand stone 24x10x6 ins., loosely set, mkd. as described in the original record and witnessed by one original bearing tree, that bears S59°W. At the corner point, set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. in diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a BLM brass cap mkd. as shown:



Established four new bearing trees:


- A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N40°E, 121 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S12 BT".
- A spruce, 12 ins. diam., bears \$23°E, 65 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W \$13 BT".
- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S81°W, 76 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S14 BT".
- A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears N25°W, 185 lks. dist., mkd. "T29N R26W S11 BT".


Buried the original sandstone alongside the iron post.

1982 Certified Corner Recordation by William Condrey No. 5425S: Found a 2 1/2 diam. iron post, with a BLM brass cap and bearing trees as described above. Set a fiberglass post alongside the corner.

- II. Found a 2 1/2 in. diam. iron pipe, protruding 14 ins. above the ground, firmly set, in a collar of stone, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. BLM brass cap mkd. as shown above. from which:
 - A burned fir snag, 9 ins. diam., bears N40°E, 79.8 ft. dist., with no visible scribe. (BLM-record)
 - A spruce snag, 21 ins. diam., bears S23°E, 42.9 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (BLM-record)
 - A burned fir stump, 32 ins. diam., bears S59°W, 15.8 ft. dist., with no visible scribe. (GLO-record)
 - A fir snag, 15 ins. diam., bears S81°W, 50.1 ft. dist., mkd. with a healed face. (BLM-record)
- III. No suitable trees within limits, therefore, from the corner point, I set four posts.
 - A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears North, on property line, 33.4 ft. dist.
 - A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears West, on property line, 40.9 ft. dist.
 - A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears East, on property line, 3.0 ft. dist.
 - A 6 ft. steel guard post, bears South, on property line, 3.0 ft. dist.
