south right of way fence.

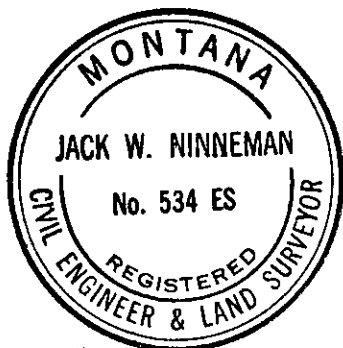
No trees in the area - so-
