

The original corner stone is lost, found the BT's as follows: Sec. 12 BT, green Ponderosa Pine, 30" dbh, w/scribing Sec. 13 BT, green Ponderosa Pine, 24" dbh, w/scribing

Original record as follows: Slate stone, 14x10x5, 9" in ground mkd CC on west, w/4 notches on S & 2 notches on N, from which a Pine, 30", N 24°W, 75 lks Pine, 20", S 47°W, 87 lks.

Date of work: 1/20/69

Set a 2" x 30" pipe two feet deep with brass cap at exact GLO distances from the original bearing trees listed above. Erected a mound of stone around the pipe.

Notched the base of each BT; painted red around the scribed blaze; added BLM - BT tags. Brass Cap stamped as shown at left.
