
- 1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position

- 3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
- 4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.

  5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor registered in the State of Montana.
- 6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

## CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

of Secs. 26,27,34,&35 29 N., Lincoln Corner\_ County

- 1903 original G.L.O. record by George A. Fessenden and Ranney Y. Lyman: "Set a slate stone, 18 X 10 X 8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, marked with 1 notch on S. and 2 notches on E. edge; from which
  - A tamarack, 6 ins. dia., bears  $N49^{\circ}E$ , 20 lks. dist., marked T29N R28W S26 BT. A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S69 30'E, 27 lks. dist., marked T29N R28W S35 BT. A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears S67 30'W, 17 lks. dist., marked T29N R28W S34 BT. A tamarack, 14 ins. dia., bears  $N40^{\circ}W$ , 18 lks. dist., marked T29N R28W S27 BT.
- II. Found a stone,  $17 \times 9 \times 6$  ins., firmly set, 13 ins. in the ground, mkd. 1 notch on S. edge and marks on E. edge are obliterated due to fractures, from which
  - A larch snag, 9 ins. dia., bears  $N44^{\circ}E$ , 12.1 ft. (18.3 lks.) dist., healed face.
  - A subalpine fir, 16 ins. dia., bears S68°W, 11.7 ft. (17.7 lks.) dist., healed face.
  - A larch, 19 ins. dia., bears N40 $^{\circ}$ W, 11.7 ft. (17.7 lks.) dist., healed face.
- III. At the corner point, set a 2 1/2 ins. dia. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 25 ins. in the ground with a 3 1/4 ins. diam. aluminum cap, marked as shown:



Bury original stone alongside new monument and raise a collar of stone around pipe.

Established two new bearing trees:

A spruce, 12 ins. dia., bears  $^{\circ}$ E, 5.5 ft. dist., mkd. T29N R28W S26 BT. A larch, 8 ins. dia., bears  $832^{\circ}$ E, 17.8 ft. dist., mkd. T29N R28W S35 BT.

Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. Magnetic Declination:  $20^{\circ}$  East.
