

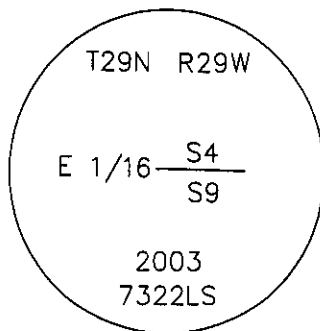
# CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

- A Ponderosa pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.17°34'E., 96.60 ft. dist., scribed E 1/16 S9 BT.

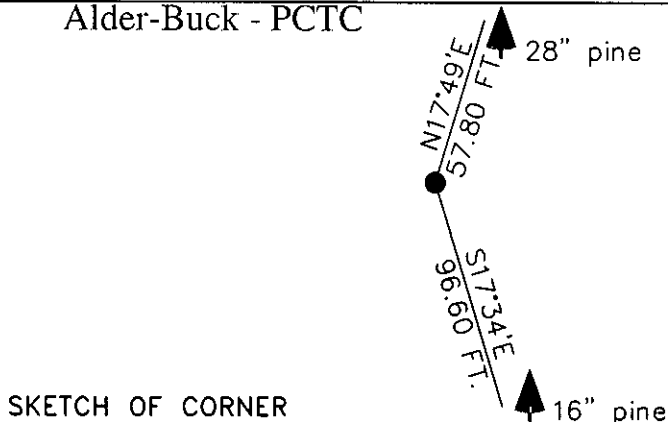
Painted 6 in. wide red bands around all bearing trees and attached Bearing tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

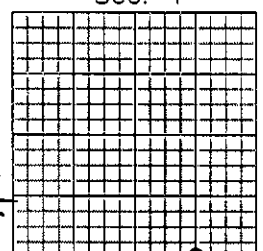
