

III. <u>Perpetuation:</u> At the calculated position from survey, set a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap on 5/8 in. diameter 24 ins. long rebar, 21 ins. in the ground, marked as shown:



From which:

A Douglas fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.52 $^{\circ}$ E., 14.95 ft. dist., scribed SE 1/16 S4 BT. A Douglas fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.19 $^{\circ}$ E., 7.50 ft. dist., scribed SE 1/16 S4 BT.

Painted 6 in. wide red bands around all bearing trees and attached new Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs on back of all bearing trees.

Magnetic declination: 20° East assumed
