4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch, example, corner marking, topographic ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

Corner E 1/16th Sections 18-19 T29 N. R. 30 W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

At the E 1/16th of Sections 18 and 19

No Original Record to Perpetuate

We set a 5/8 inch diameter by 24 inch long rebar with a yellow PVC plastic cap stamped: MDL 4232 S from which we established the following bearing trees and tags:

An 11 inch diameter Lodge Pole Pine bears N32°W 6.9 feet to center of tree scribed E1/16 S18 BT near the base of tree.

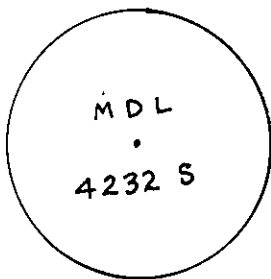
A 10 inch diameter Lodge Pole Pine bears S41/4°E 28.2 feet to center of tree scribed E 1/16 S19 BT near the base of tree.

Both BTs tagged by KEI {LAD & GEB 5/18/82} and painted red.

A 6 inch diameter Lodge Pole Pine bears S53°W 7.1 feet with interior Section Location Poster scratched E1/16 Section 19 T.29 N. R.30W., P.M.M.

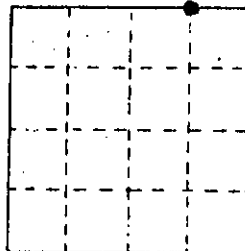
