

- II. Found a set stone, 15x6x4 ins., 5 ins. above ground, mkd. 1/4 on W. face, from which

A mound of stone, 2 ft. diam. x 1 1/2 ft. high, bears West, 5.5 ft.

III. At the corner point, set a 2 1/2 ins. diam. aluminum pipe, 30 ins. long, 15 ins. in the ground with attached 3 1/4 ins. diam., U.S.D.A. Forest Service aluminum cap marked as shown:



Established two new bearing trees:

A ponderosa pine, 10 ins. diam., bears $N23^{\circ}W$, 13.4 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S27 BT. A douglas fir, 6 ins. diam., bears $S75^{\circ}W$, 23.9 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S34 BT.

Painted a red band around each bearing tree and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

Bury original stone alongside pipe monument.

Set a 6 ft. galvanized steel guard post with Land Survey Marker and Property Boundary decals attached, 5 ft., East from corner.
