Pittman et al: "The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, monumented with a slate stone,  $14 \times 10 \times 5$  ins., loosely set and mkd. 1/4 on the W. face, and witnessed by the original bearing trees: At the corner point; set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T29N R30W 1/4 S16 S15 1964

The original bearing trees:

A pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S14 1/2°E, 26 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze. (Record: S13 20'E, 26 1ks.) A larch, 7 ins. diam., bears \$30 1/2 W, 23 lks. dist., mkd. with an overgrown blaze. (Record: \$34 35'W, 23 1ks.)

Bury the original stone alongside of the iron post."

1985 Certified Corner Recordation by Thomas C. Hill, 5612-S: Established one new bearing tree:

A larch, 12 ins. diam., bears \$36°E, 38.3 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 \$15 BT.

Set a guard post with Survey Marker decal attached near the corner.


