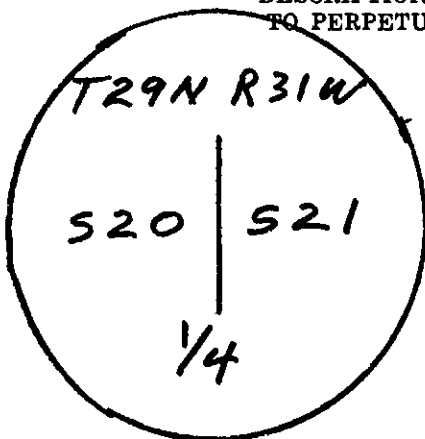
The original corner post and bearing trees were not found.

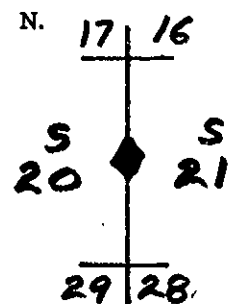
